MINIMUM QUALIFICATION

Masters degree in education, special education, adult education or counseling, plus three to five years of relevant experience, or a combination of education and experience from which comparable knowledge and skills are acquired.

- Familiarity with social service agencies.
- Good counseling and advising skills.
- Ability to deal effectively with a wide range of individuals and groups within and outside of the college, requiring coordinating, liaison, advocacy.
